

Internet Banking First Time Login User Instructions

1. Go to www.fnbcreston.com
2. Click the Account Access section on the right side, then click "**Enroll Now**" in the login box.
3. Choose your account type within the drop down box provided. Type in your account number, social security number, first time login pin, date of birth, e-mail address and confirm your e-mail address.

4. Read the Internet Terms & Conditions. After reading the terms, if you agree, select the "**I agree**" button. If you choose not to accept the terms and select "Decline," you will be exited out of internet banking and will not be able to complete the enrollment process.
5. The Establish Credentials screen will pop up. You will be asked to enter a username which is case sensitive and requires at least 6 characters (maximum of 19). Your new password is case sensitive and must be a **minimum of 8 characters in length (maximum of 17) and contain the following: 2 letters, 2 numbers and 1 capitalized letter**. Re-enter the same password to confirm the initial password was entered correctly. After completing this step, click **Continue**.
6. Complete the three challenge questions and answers. Finally, if you would like to register your private computer, click the "**Don't challenge me again on this device**" box.
7. Congratulations, you have successfully enrolled in internet banking! For security purposes, if your internet banking account has not been accessed for at least 90 days, your internet banking account will become inactive and you will need to complete the first-time enrollment process to gain internet banking access.
